- □JAE Registration Period: From 3.00pm on 12 Jan 2023 (Thursday) to 4.00pm on 17 Jan 2023 (Tuesday)

#### Important information

#### 1. You should consider your course choices wisely.

Applicants are posted to a course <u>based on merit</u> according to <u>net aggregate</u> scores

- net L1R5 for JC course
- net L1R4 for MI course
- net ELR2B2 for Polytechnics courses and
- net ELB4/ELR1B3/ELR2B2 for ITE courses

It is important that you should consider courses with eligibility criteria that are comparable to your aggregate scores, for better fit and higher chances of being admitted.

#### Important information

- 2. You should make full use of your 12 choices, (where applicable).
  - It is **not advisable** to only make a few course choices
  - You are strongly encouraged to indicate at least 2-3 courses where your aggregate scores are much better than the previous year's course cut-off points (COP)
  - You are strongly encouraged to use the JAE worksheet (provided in Form A or the JAE information booklet) before submitting your online application.
- **3.** Whilst appealing for a transfer to another JC can be done after the JAE posting results are released, please note that your appeal is subjected to available vacancies and school's admission criteria.

#### **JOINT ADMISSIONS EXERCISE (JAE) 2023**

- □ Results of the JAE will be released on 2 February 2023 (Thursday) through the following modes:
  - ☐ Short Message Service (SMS) to the Singapore mobile phone number provided by the applicant during registration
  - ☐ JAE-IS, which is accessible through the JAE website
- □ Applicants posted to **JC and MI** are to report to their posted institutions on <u>3</u> February 2023 (Friday). Any student who does not report to the JC or MI on this date will be deemed to have forfeited his/her place.
- ☐ If students are unable to report to their posted JC or MI on the first day of school due to valid reasons, they may contact their posted school directly to confirm that they are taking up the place, and the school will be able to reserve the place for them
- □ Applicants posted to **polytechnics or ITE** will receive an email or package via mail on the enrolment details by **end-February 2023**.

#### Direct School Admission (DSA) – JCs

□Students who had accepted offers through the 2022 Direct School Admission – Junior Colleges (DSA-JC) will be admitted to their chosen JC if they have met the **eligibility criteria** for admission based on their GCE O-Level examination results. Students admitted to a JC through DSA-JC will not be eligible to participate in the JAE.

□Students who do not meet the JC admission criteria may take part in the JAE to apply for other courses which they are eligible for.

## Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) – Polytechnics

□Students who had earlier accepted conditional offers to a polytechnic course through the Polytechnic Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) in 2022 will have their offers confirmed and will not be eligible to participate in the JAE, if they meet the criteria.

□Students who do not meet the criteria may still apply for polytechnic admission via the JAE for courses which they are eligible for.

#### Successful PFP and/or DPP applicants

- □Last day of school for current sec 5 students going to DPP will be 24 Jan 2023 (Tuesday). Students will need to report to ITE for DPP on 25 Jan 2023 (Wednesday)
- □ Existing DPP students who have successfully applied to PFP will need to apply to ITE for withdrawal from DPP first before they are able to take up the PFP offer.
- □DPP-enrolled students should check with their ITE class advisor for more details on the DPP withdrawal process and deadlines for withdrawal.
- □ Last day of school for current sec 5 students going to PFP will be 27 Jan 2023 (Friday).
- Respective polytechnics will inform students of the enrolment dates for PFP.

- ☐ The candidate will be informed of the outcome via a letter through the school. No report on the candidate's performance will be provided.
- □ Outcomes of appeal are expected to be released to schools by **24 Feb 2023 (Friday).**

#### **Certificate Amendment**

- Candidates may request for a re-print of their certificate only if their names were printed wrongly due to misspelling
- There will be an <u>amendment fee of \$50 (inclusive of GST)</u> for each certificate that require a re-print
- Request and payment must be submitted through school to SEAB by 31 March 2023.
